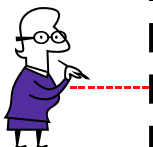

Which Learning Center Sessions are Restricted – and WHY

- Other than writing tutorials, tutoring by appointment is limited to undergraduates who use the Learning Center's federally funded TRiO CATS/Student Support Services (SSS*) Program and to undergraduates with academic need who are either from an under-represented minority group or are registered with the Office of Disability Services or the MU Veterans Center.

- These students are identified by The Learning Center prior to the start of each semester and are informed by email that they can seek tutoring by appointment through our program.

- When qualified tutors are available, students are assigned personal tutors who work with them throughout the semester.

- We do not offer tutoring by appointment to students for classes not taught at MU or for independent study or online classes.

*SSS is funded with a grant from the U.S. Department of Education. Its goal is to provide assistance to students based upon a combination of factors including family income, parents' education level, and disability status in order to increase their retention and graduation rates from college.



The Learning Center serves about 2/3 of first-year students.

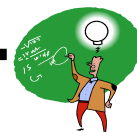
FREE SERVICES FOR ALL UNDERGRADUATES:

Learning Center Help Sessions







- The Learning Center's **Master Schedule** (<http://learningcenter.missouri.edu/pdfs/master.pdf>) provides an overview of Learning Center (LC) Help Sessions and Exam Reviews.
- Weekly sessions extend classroom learning through interactive tutoring and are typically offered on a small group basis where attendance varies.
- Sessions are scheduled for general education classes that students generally consider difficult and for other classes that the LC receives many requests for assistance in (see below).
